Culture of Learning

Student learning is at the centre of our school culture. We are committed to ensuring our students are “World Ready” as we develop their academic and personal skills to be prepared for jobs that, as yet, do not exist.

To optimise the learning experience throughout the school years, our teachers are empowered to provide rigorous and engaging experiences and opportunities for our students to “learn by doing”, based on their individual strengths.

In Playgroup, for children from 6 months to 3 years of age, our teachers develop high quality, creative and dynamic educational programs based upon the Reggio Emilia philosophy.

Our Early Learning Centre supports and stimulates students from 3 to 5 years of age, to develop numeracy, literacy and active participation skills through simple and structured routine. This helps our students to become more independent, confident and resilient in preparation for formal schooling.
